Social Events

The Finnish SCOR Committee, particularly Jorma Kuparinen and Riitta Autio, have arranged a full social schedule for the SCOR annual meeting in Helsinki. A map will be added to this information soon.

Monday (Sept. 12, 18:00-19:00)—We will walk from the meeting venue (Tieteiden talo, Kirkkokatu 6) a couple of blocks to the "Vanha Raatihuone" (Aleksanterinkatu 20) for a reception offered by the City of Helsinki. Appetizers and refreshments will be served.

Tuesday (Sept. 13, 18:00-??)—SCOR and the Finnish SCOR Committee will host this dinner for meeting participants, at the Suomenlinna fortress (see <http://www.suomenlinna.fi/en/>). The afternoon session will end by 17:30, so we can catch the ferry at 18.00. The ferry is located at Market Place, a short walk from the meeting location. The ferry trip takes about 15 minutes, after which it is a short walk to the restaurant. Drinks will start at 18.30 and dinner at about 19:00.

Wednesday (Sept. 14)—We will have the Baltic Sea seminar from 8.30 to 13:00 at the University of Helsinki main building (Fabianinkatu 33). After that, we'll continue the meeting in Tieteiden talo. We will take a bus from the meeting location at 17.30 and drive to the harbor of Vuosaari (this takes about 30 minutes), where we will give a presentation about the place and about Finnish research on ice-going ships. Our host will be Mikko Niini from <http://www.akerarctic.fi/>. Dinner will be served there. We will leave for the city at about 21.30 and be back at the hotel by 22.00.
