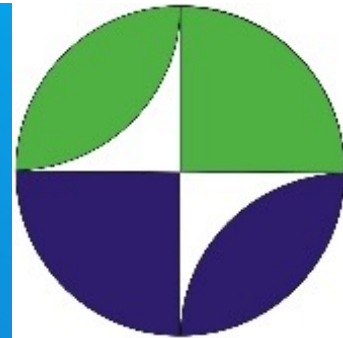


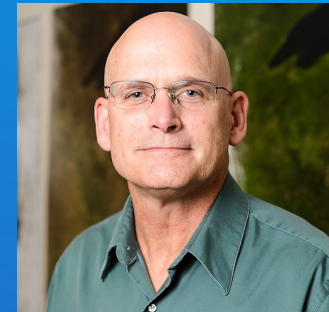

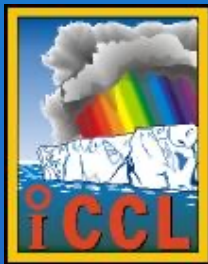
The IAMAS Bureau has meets monthly, to decide day-to-day operations of the organization

- All of the commissions held meetings/webinars this past year:
 - *International Global Atmospheric Chemistry/International Commission on Atmospheric Chemistry and Global Pollution*: 10-15 September 2022 virtual and in-person in Manchester, UK
 - International Commission on Atmospheric Electricity: 19-24 June 2022 in Tel Aviv, Israel
 - The *International Commission on Climate* organized several sessions associated with other meetings
 - *International Commission on Clouds and Precipitation (ICCP)*: 2-6 August 2021 originally scheduled for Pune, India, but held virtually
 - *International Commission on the Middle Atmosphere (ICDM)*: held 2 workshops, 1 in Helsinki, one hybrid in Sopron, Hungary
 - *International Commission on Planetary Atmospheres and their Evolution (ICPAE)*: Initiated a monthly webinar series
 - *The International Commission on Polar Meteorology (ICPM)* has initiated a set of monthly webinars
 - *International Ozone Commission (IOC)* hosted the Quadrennial Ozone Symposium 3-9 October 2021 virtually from Daejeon, South Korea
 - *International Radiation Commission (IRS)*: held a symposium 4-8 July 2022 in Thessalonika, Greece.
